Guidelines

1. The exhibit is open to digital artists of all ages. (Parental permission needed if under 18)
2. No entry fee is required.
3. Framed Artwork is appreciated. Unframed work should be mounted on poster board.
4. Artists may submit up to five pieces.
5. When possible, prints from Genesee County will be exhibited in the Senior Center and prints from Orleans County will be exhibited at the Shirt Factory Café.
6. Artists may offer their entries for sale if desired. GO ART! will receive a 10% commission for each work sold. Sales tax is the responsibility of the artist.
7. Insurance coverage for damage or loss of the exhibited artwork is the responsibility of the artist.
8. Art work should be dropped off at GO ART!, Seymour Place, 201 East Main Street Batavia or at the Shirt Factory Café, 115 West Center Street, Medina **by Friday, February 17, 2011.**
9. Prints should be labeled on the back with your name and title of work and price, if for sale.
10. Opening receptions will be held at both galleries on Friday, March 16 from 5 to 7 pm.(tentative)
11. GO ART! will provide publicity for the show and opening reception and programs for the exhibits.
